Local Law No. 1 of 1994

A Local Law providing a Four-year Term for the Elective Offices of Town Clerk and Town Tax Collector of the Town of Brighton

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Brighton as follows:

Section 1. The term of the office of the elective Town Clerk and the elective Town Tax Collector of the Town of Brighton shall be four years. Such four-year term shall commence on the first day of January following the first biennial town election after the effective date of this local law.

Section 2. At the biennial town election next following the effective date of this local law, and every four years thereafter, the Town Clerk and Town Tax Collector shall be elected each for a term of four years.

Section 3. This local law shall supersede in its application to the Town of Brighton Section Twenty-Four of the Town Law with respect to the terms of office of the elective Town Clerk and elective Town Tax Collector.

Section 4. This local law shall be submitted for approval to the electors of the Town of Brighton at the next biennial town election held not less than sixty days after its adoption.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State after approval by a majority of the electors voting thereon in accordance with the requirements of Section Twenty-Three of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
