NOTICE OF HEARING: Notice of this hearing was published in the Adirondack Daily Enterprise on Friday, July 30 and Thursday, August 5. Notices were posted at three local post offices, businesses in the Town, and on the Town Clerk's Sign Board at the Highway Garage on Wednesday, July 28, 2010.

Supervisor John Quenell said the purpose of the hearing was to allow the "Over the Hill" property (Tax Map #381.-1-15) owner (Francesco Bennici) to express an opinion of an assessment to the property for the cost of removal of a building from the property by the Town to be due on January 1, 2010.
