

Town of Brighton
Special Meeting
Brighton Town Hall (presently situated in the Town Garage)

July 12, 2010

Supervisor John Quenell called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Council members present were Steve Tucker and Jeffrey Leavitt.
Absent were: Peter Shrope and Lydia Wright

Mr. Quenell reported that pursuant to a directive by the board at their July 8 meeting he had contacted Lt. Ellithorpe of the DEC to request a reduction in the fine levied for alleged violation of New York Codes dealing with solid waste management practices. Lt. Ellithorpe's response indicated that due to the town's timely remediation of the violation he had, in fact, issued a reduced fine of \$500, the standard fine for such violation would have been \$7500 and there would be no further reduction.

Mr. Quenell then offered the following resolution:

Whereas, the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation has ordered the town to pay a \$500 fine in connection with the alleged unlawful disposal of waste during the June 1 and June 3 removal of the "Over the Hill" structure at 474 State Route 86,

Be it Resolved that the town agrees to pay the fine and further authorizes the supervisor to sign the Consent Order, Number LER5-10-009953.

Mr. Tucker seconded the resolution.

After the discussion, the resolution was adopted by the following vote:

Mr. Leavitt – Aye

Mr. Tucker – Aye

Mr. Quenell – Aye.

Mr. Quenell then asked that the voucher for payment of the \$500 to the DEC be signed by all present. The voucher was signed and a motion was made by the supervisor that he be authorized to pay it. The motion was seconded by Mr. Tucker and adopted by the following vote:

Mr. Leavitt – Aye

Mr. Tucker – Aye

Mr. Quenell – Aye.

At 6:40 p.m. Mr. Leavitt moved to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Tucker and carried by voice vote.

The meeting was adjourned.
