RESOLUTION #79-2000
REQUEST FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FROM THE APA ON PROJECT #2000-54

WHEREAS, Mr. Adrien Girouard and Ms. Julie King have applied to the Department of Environmental Conservation and the Adirondack Park Agency for a permit (APA Project Notice #2000-54) to open a gravel mine on Mr. Girouard's property adjacent to the Rainbow Lake Road, and

WHEREAS, many area residents have expressed concern to members of the Town Board, the Department of Environmental Conservation, and the Adirondack Park Agency over the possible noise, dust, traffic, child safety, watershed and well water contamination impacts from the proposed gravel mine, and

WHEREAS, the Brighton town board believes that all citizens who may be affected by the gravel mine should have an opportunity in a public forum to express opinions and ask questions of the applicant, the Department of Environmental Conservation, and the Adirondack Park Agency concerning the proposed gravel mine,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the town board of the Town of Brighton respectfully requests the Adirondack Park Agency, acting as the lead agency in the matter of their Project Number 2000-54, to conduct a public hearing and provide detailed proceedings of that hearing for consideration by the members of the Agency.
