A Special Meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Brighton was held at 7:00 p.m. at the Brighton Town Garage, 17 County Road 31, Paul Smiths, NY.

CALL TO ORDER: The meeting was called to order by Supervisor John Quenell at 7:04 p.m.

PRESENT: John Quenell, Council Members Lydia Wright, Steve Tucker, Jeffrey Leavitt.

SCHEDULING OF MEETINGS:

Mr. Quenell asked for comments on his wish to call a Special Meeting, also commonly called an Organizational Meeting, in advance of the scheduled Regular Meeting on January 13, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at the present temporary location of the board meeting room. There was no dissent.

Mr. Quenell asked for comments on his wish to call a Public Hearing toward the end of January at the PSGVFD firehouse for the purpose of seeking public input regarding the future of Camp Gabriels. He noted that Brighton resident Robert Eckert had volunteered to conduct the meeting. After a brief discussion there was agreement to scheduling the meeting for 7:00 p.m. on January 26.

Mr. Quenell said he would shortly call the meetings by U.S. Mail notice to council members.


EXECUTIVE SESSION:
